The Guideline Rules for all Classes

1. All exhibitors enter their exhibits at their own risk.
2. Exhibits / displays can commence from 2pm on Thursday 8th February 2018 until 8pm.
3. Exhibits / displays will be accepted on the morning of Friday 9th February 2018 until 9:30am.
4. Judging will commence at 10am Friday 9th February 2018.
5. Exhibits / displays must be the individual work of the competitor unless there is a class with a group listing.
6. No artificial or dried materials can be used unless stated in the class title.
7. Pre-constructed and pre-woven materials can be used—but should not dominate the finished design.
8. Plant materials must last for the duration of the Show and should be in a water source or else replaced if required by the competitor.
9. Judges or Stewards will be available after lunch to discuss awards and give constructive comments to competitors where required.
10. Junior competitors will have the Judge's comments available either with the Judge or from the Stewards who will have been given the information by the Judge.
