Entry Fee \$ 2.00 per entry to a maximum of \$ 10.00

Conditions of entry

- Articles are not to have been exhibited at a previous Glen Innes Show
- Exhibits must conform to weight and length where stated
- Exhibits must be entirely the work of the exhibitor
- Knitted garments must be as new ie unworn
- Woven articles except for tapestry weaves and floor rugs must be washed as part of the finishing process
- Where articles are made up, the finishing process is judged
- Skeins to be tied with the same yarn as the skein.
- All spinning entries are to include a staple of the fleece and the purpose of the yarn
- All skeins must weigh 25 grams or more
- A novice is a person who has never entered in their specific class of the Glen Innes Show before

Spinning – Open Section

1. Handspun article, knitted or crocheted for an adult
2. Handspun article, knitted or crocheted for a child
3. Handspun scarf - any fibre
4. Skein of handspun plied wool
5. Skein of handspun plied alpaca
6. Skein of handspun mixed fibres and novelty/plied fibres
7. Any other article of handspun fibre
8. 2 skeins of handspun fibre - dyed with natural dyes. State materials and mordant used.
9. 2 skeins of handspun fibre - dyed with different commercial dyes. State materials and dyes used
10. Any other article of handspun fibre by a spinner over 70 years
11. Any other article of handspun fibre by a spinner over 80 years
12. Any handspun article by a novice
13. Skein of yarn prepared and handspun from raw fleece, include a staple of the fleece



Spinning and Weaving – Junior Section (u/17 yrs)

14. Any handspun or hand woven article knitted or crocheted by a person under 17 yrs
15. Skein of yarn prepared and handspun from raw fleece, include a staple of the fleece

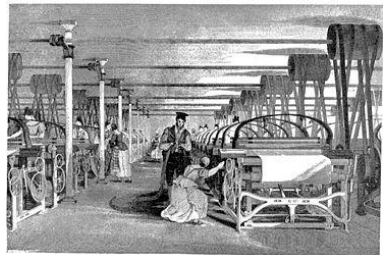
Weaving – Open Section

16. Hand woven scarf - any fibre
17. Hand woven stole or shawl any fibre
18. Handspun, hand woven any article
19. Any article hand woven by a novice
20. Any felted article
21. Any felted article by a novice
22. Any other article not mentioned
23. Any other article woven by a weaver over 70 years
24. Any other article woven by a weaver over 80 years
