- 1 White Rose

- One Fully Blown Rose – showing stamens
- 1 cut Floribunda Rose – 4 or more blooms
- Container of Roses – decorative, 7 blooms, 2 distinct colours or more
- Container of Roses – decorative, 5 blooms, 1 colour
- 1 cut Miniature Rose
- Vase of Miniature Roses, any colour
- Bowl of mixed Roses (A bowl is any container wider than high and is not provided by the stewards)

- Dahlias under 160mm must be staged 3 blooms per vase to be eligible for a Championship Award
