Conditions of Entry

- All exhibits in this section must not have won a prize at any previous Show of this Society, and must be the bona-fide work of the exhibitor
- Articles must not be washed except where otherwise stated. Cleanliness is essential to all work under penalty of disqualification.
- Specimen means ONE article only
- If less than two exhibits in class only 1st Prize will be awarded— at the Judge's discretion.
- No makers' name or label are to be on any specimen.
- Small articles should be mounted on cardboard, ie doilies, handkerchiefs and bookmarks.
- Crochet not to be mounted
- Lace or silk trimming is allowed in knitting and crochet work
- Wool label to be attached to woollen garments
- A return **Postage Paid** bag **MUST** be forwarded with all entries, otherwise they will not be returned at Show Society's expense

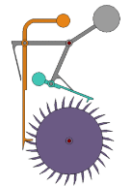

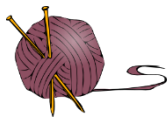

Conditions of Entry:

A complete entry will consist of : the **Garment** made and the **Garment Note** ● .
Your entry must be your own work.

The garment to be entered can only be the “Pussycat Bow Blouse” as above **

The garment is to be all or partly made from repurposed fabric or items e.g. recycle buttons, zips etc.

You will need to include with your entry a Garment Note ● that includes:

- What materials you have used that are new
- What materials you have used that are recycled/repurposed
- Whether you have altered the pattern (eg for sizing) and how you did it.
- Whether you received any help making your entry, who helped you and how.
- The Garment Note will need to be attached to your Garment and the two items will be part of the entry to be judged.
