National Sheep Health Statement and Vendor Declarations to accompany all exhibits

OVINE BRUCELLOSIS, FOOTROT & JOHNE'S DISEASE

THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED BY THE COMMITTEE

All sheep must be from ovine brucellosis-free, footrot-free, and Johne's disease-free flocks. Papers must be sighted before sheep are unloaded.

Johne's Disease: Exhibitors are required to have a signed Health Declaration that to their knowledge their sheep have not been in contact with any stock which have originated from a property which is known to have been infected with Johne's Disease, and are required to declare that Johne's Disease is not known or suspected to have occurred in the past five (5) years on the property from which the sheep have come.

All MN1 Status Studs will be penned and unloaded separately.

- Exhibitors are requested to forward their entries as soon as possible. Anyone wishing to bring sheep on Friday, please ring the Chief Steward and this will be arranged, or anyone wishing to leave sheep on the grounds Friday night please inform the Chief Steward
- Sheep to be penned **before 9am Saturday 10th February 2024**
- Judging will commence at **9:30am on Saturday 10th February 2024**
- Shorn short-wool sheep to have no more than one (1) cm of wool. Shorn long-wool sheep to have no more than two (2) cm of wool. This will be strictly adhered to.
- Shedding sheep must have been shorn no more than 28 days prior to the Show
- The judge is empowered to transfer sheep which he considers to be entered in the wrong class.
- Any sheep infested with lice or ked or otherwise diseased shall be immediately removed from the grounds and **shall not be judged.**
- It is the owner's responsibility to feed and water the exhibits whilst on the showground.
- **Maximum 3 entries per class per exhibitor**

All vehicles are to be removed from the vicinity of the Sheep pavilions immediately following delivery of exhibits. Members with a valid Members Car Pass will allow the vehicle to be parked only in the Members Car Parking area, but no exhibitors' vehicles are to be parked west of Yarraford Hall gate.
