Entry Forms and Signed Waiver Forms (not the exhibited items) are to be submitted to the Secretary's Office before 4pm Monday 5th February 2024

Conditions of entry:

- All entries to be framed (can be on black cardboard), with name, age, school, class and section on the **back of each exhibit** – If on hard board or in a frame, **the item must have wire or fittings**, so as to be able to hang on the wall.
- Exhibits must be delivered **between 4pm - 5pm on Tuesday 6th February 2024 to the Pavilion** with the **exhibit ticket** attached to the front of artwork.
- If the school/teacher intends to organise entries for a whole class, individual forms **MUST** be submitted prior to hanging. **Teachers - please include the name/initial of the child's school on the back of all student art work and display entry tickets on the front. This helps on pack down day.**
- **Some schools may prefer to email entries in for processing, prior to paying and collecting tickets.**
- **Entry forms will not be filled out by stewards due to time restrictions. NO** entries or money will be taken on art drop-off day.

Exhibits may not be removed from display before 12 noon Sunday 11th February 2024.

The pavilion stewards will be on hand for collection of exhibits, and distribution of prize money, from 12pm to 1pm Sunday 11th February 2024.

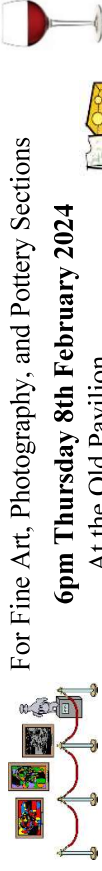
